## Canada seen producing more wheat, canola, barley and oats in 2022

OTTAWA, Dec 2 (Reuters) - Canadian farmers reported producing more wheat, canola, barley, and oats in 2022, according to a farm survey by Statistics Canada released on Friday. Better growing conditions relative to 2021 across much of western Canada contributed to improved yields.

The survey of approximately 27,200 Canadian farms was conducted from October 7 until November 14, 2022.

NOTE: Analysts and traders surveyed by Reuters on average estimated stockpiles at 34.8 mln tonnes of all wheat, 5.9 mln tonnes of durum wheat, 19.2 mln tonnes of canola, 4.7 mln tonnes of oats, and 9.6 mln tonnes of barley.
